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The five stages of a genre-approach to writing are (Hyland, 2007): 1. Setting the context 2. Modelling 3. Joint construction 4. Independent construction 5. Comparing. Theory and practice. The goal of the setting the context stage is to explore the communicative purpose (e.g., to persuade readers to care for the environment) of a particular genre. Learners can read a text and discuss its communicative purpose with their classmates.

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Approaches to the teaching of writing

The process approach treats all writing as a creative act which requires time and positive feedback to be done well. In process writing, the teacher moves away from being someone who sets students a writing topic and receives the finished product for correction without any intervention in the writing process itself.

Most research in writing pedagogy today concludes that the most effective way to teach writing is through a process approach. This approach assumes that a writ-

er needs to be writing for authentic purposes in an extended process that includes prewriting, writing, revising, and editing--though these are done in a recursive manner rather than in discrete steps.

The Process Approach

A writing process approach requires that teachers give students greater responsibility for, and ownership of, their own learning. Students make decisions about genre and choice of topics, and collaborate as they write. A hybrid of the process approach, and the genre approach, which we will turn to now.

Penmanship focused on transcription—the physical act of writing—and it involved producing legible, accurate, and even beautifully formed letters on the page.

Typically students are given a model text to study, analyze and then imitate by writing a similar text. The product approach is a traditional approach to teaching writing used to minimize students' difficulties in writing, this approach assumes it is best to get them to start writing from a very controlled basis.
